Tham Wan teaches there fulltime and also function in the administrative role of "Seminary Advancement Director." We also avail ourselves to the regional Bible

Schools. We have taught at BCM, TCA Malaysia and also SATI in Malang, Indonesia. In the coming days, we see ourselves traveling more often for this purpose. We are thankful for budget airlines that have made this possible!

Develop a new model for reaching Filipino Chinese with the Pentecostal message. There are almost no Chinese churches or congregations among the Assemblies of God. We are using BACC as the environment where this new model could be tried out.

Research and write. With the splendid APTS library facilities and the encouragement of colleagues, we are looking forward to do more research and write.

Help raise up a strong city church in Baguio. We are committed to Baguio Assembly City Church (BACC) because we believe in the Pauline strategy of building strong missions centers in the cities. BACC has sent out workers to the Philippines as well as Malaysia, Korea, USA, Cambodia and even in the Middle-Eastern country of Dubai.

We continue to have visitors from Malaysia coming either to take advantage of the APTS programs or to do some short term missions in the mountain churches around Baguio.

We hosted the missions team from the Multi-Media University (MMU) led by Pastor Joanne Lee. We arranged for them to minister around Baguio and also in Manila. Seeing the passion these young people has for the Lord's work encouraged us.

We also had Pastor Yeu Chuen and family come by when he was doing his D.Min. module. His family had been friends for many years so

having them in our home here was a special blessing for us.
