Moon Tee was back Baguio for a few days to check on the Chinese congregation we pioneered a few months ago. The congregation is called BICC, which stands for "Baguio International Chinese Church." This "church" is run as a language department of Baguio Assembly, similar to the practice of multi-language ministries of Malay-

sian assemblies.

We are very proud of the members of BICC when they took an offering for the disasters in China and Myanmar. They did that totally on their own initiative. We were not there at that time to tell them what to do. The money has been given to WAGRA Malaysia for relief work in Myanmar and China.

## MAY & JUNE ITINERATION

We are still home on furlough. The itineration has been going well. We have been kept very busy preaching and teaching. We are thankful for friends who have trusted us with their pulpits.

Among the churches we have visited during May and June included: Botanic Family Church in Klang, Bethany Chapel in Kepong, Berean AG in Desa Petaling, Emmanuel AG in Cheras, Trinity Community Center in P.J., Shiloh AG in Setapak, the Vineyard Church in Old Klang

Road, Peace City Tabernacle in Sunway, Revival Center in Ampang, Canaan Church Taman Sejahtera, Calvary Life and Bethel in Melaka, Peace Charis in Serdang, Gemas AG, Calvary AG in Taman Desa, Elim AG in Kepong, Harvest AG in Klang, and New Life AG in P.J.

During the same period, we also taught 2 courses for the Bible College of Malaysia (BCM) and 1 course for the GT School of Ministry (GTSOM).

## MORE SPONSORS NEEDED

We are helping facilitate students from Chinese house church training centers to continue their theological education outside of China. 3 of them are already in APTS while another 9 will be going to BCM. The expenses for their air fares and passport charges will be paid for by the Chinese church. (It is encouraging to see the Chinese

church participating in the further education of their future leaders.) We will raise the support to cover their expenses during the period of studies in the Philippines and Malaysia. Already, 4 or 5 churches have agreed to sponsor one student each in Malaysia. We still have some ways to go but we believe the sponsorship will come in.
